10 Economic Rules: Why we need a Guaranteed Livable Income (GLI)

- **1. Production needs consumption**: Every act of production needs an act of consumption.
- **2. Free Will**: There is no moral or scientific principle that compels us to consume non-essentials.
- **3. Economic Growth needs Population Growth**: Without a GLI economic growth requires population growth.
- **4. Damage to the Earth**: Producing non-essentials just to create jobs wastes and damages nature.
- **5. Damage to Health**: Producing ill-health products to create jobs ruins health (especially children's).
- **6. Unemployment needed**: Our current economic system depends joblessness to curb inflation.
- **7. Automation**: The job of industry is not to create jobs but to create higher profits by cutting jobs whenever possible with automation, layoffs and outsourcing.
- **8. Overproduction**: Higher productivity means we can now produce more than people can consume.
- **9. Limits to Consumption**: *Impossible to consume enough essential goods & services for full employment.*
- **10. Poverty = no ability to consume**: Over-production = waste if people have no purchasing power.
